## Why donors fund awards and scholarships

- To encourage research in area they are passionate about
- Illness or area of research has touched their lives or the lives of loved ones
- It may be to remember a family member, a friend or colleague



## How many are available and what is the value

- Currently there are 13 donor funded scholarships
- Vary from \$1,000 to \$8,000



## How do I qualify and what are my obligations?

- Visit the UNSW Scholarship's website
- Some awards require a report at the end of the year or a short presentation
- We ask that all recipients write a thank you letter
- The Development Office manages the relationship between the recipients and the donors



## How do I apply

- Apply online via UNSW Scholarship's website <https://scholarships.online.unsw.edu.au/index.html>
- A range of different scholarships and awards available
- Applications usually open July to September and November to February

<a href="#">Rose Ling Lang Award in Medicine</a>	To undertake study or attend a conference related to their Honours work at an overseas university.	\$3000
